In order for us to be able to organize your transfer better, you must state the following purpose: **Competitor Last Name, First Name, Date of Birth,**

#### **Important instructions:**

- All Tournament fees are non-refundable.
- If no assignment can be made, you may incur additional costs of 15 € when registering on August 1st, 2022.
- **If payment is not received within 72 hours, your registration will be considered invalid and you will need to register again.**

#### **Expense allowance:**

In order to keep the organizational effort on the fight week as low as possible and to organize a smooth competition, the following changes must be reported by e-mail to [betriebssportgemeinschaft@ble.de](mailto:betriebssportgemeinschaft@ble.de) by July 18th at the latest:

- Change of disciplines (no late entry of additional disciplines)
- Change in weight class

**If the report is made after July 18th or during registration, an expense allowance of 15 € per change must be paid.**

**The following COVID requirements for an event like the World Championship would apply to you at the moment:**

I do not want to or cannot make different rules for competitors and spectators, otherwise we would have to prevent these two parties from mixing and I do not see or want to see that at such an event as the World Championships. Therefore the same rules apply.

**Medical mask or FFP2 (N95) requirement in the venue, except at the seat or during the competitions.**

We differentiate between three groups in Germany.

1. Fully vaccinated with official certificate: These people do not have to test themselves daily. However, Rapid COVID-19 Antigen Self-Tests are made available and requested to be carried out in order to ensure a level of security. The country directors check the results of their competitors. As I said, it's voluntary.
2. Recovered people (less than 3 month) with official certificate: These people do not need to test themselves daily. However, Rapid COVID-19 Antigen Self-Tests are made available and requested to be carried out in order to ensure a level of security. The country directors check the results of their competitors. As I said, it's voluntary.

This group is currently excluded from attending any sporting event such as the World Championship in Germany:

3. People who are not fully vaccinated or have not recovered need a negative rapid antigen test (maximum 24 hours old). The result must be shown to the organizer when entering the hall.

There are testing facilities nearby. These tests are subject to a fee and are not covered by the organizer. The price per official test is currently 15 euros.

We assume that the legal situation in Germany will change by summer, so that the third group can also participate.

However, we recommend, if possible, to be fully vaccinated so that you are on the safe side and you will not incur any unexpected costs.

We will try to inform you about the latest changes regarding the COVID regulations. We would also like to ask you to follow the following website:

## GSBA 2022 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP RELEASE FROM LIABILITY WAIVER FORM

**1. Voluntary Application:**

I, the undersigned, acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate in the Global Stick and Blade Alliance (GSBA) World Championships hosted by GSBA Germany e.V. and Betriebssportgemeinschaft der BLE e.V.

**2. Assumption of Risk:**

I am aware and understand that in general, competition involving Eskrima, Kali, and Arnis martial arts are inherently dangerous and hazardous activities. I am voluntarily and of my own free will assuming all risks, of any nature, associated with this tournament with full knowledge, acceptance and understanding of the hazards involved.

**3. Health Advisory and Condition:**

I hereby acknowledge and understand that participating in this event involves extremely strenuous physical activity and heavy physical contact, and that I have been advised to consult a physician before commencing and undertaking such activity. I hereby represent that, to the best of my knowledge, I am in good physical health and condition, sufficient to undertake this dangerous and hazardous competition. I agree that I will notify tournament officials if I am injured or become ill and not participate in the tournament if injured.

**4. Medical Assistance:**

I grant permission, in case of injury, to have medical personnel at the tournament provide me with medical assistance or treatment for such injury. This treatment will be of "first aid" nature only and your injury may require you to seek additional medical treatment beyond that administered at the tournament.

**5. Photo/Video:**

I further consent that any pictures, video or film furnished by me or taken of me in connection with this tournament may be used by the GSBA promoters or directors for publicity, promotions, or advertisement via social media, television, magazines or any other manner they may deem necessary. The undersigned specifically waives any intellectual property rights to those images or videos which would be taken during the tournament, waives any and all claims, of any nature, which might arise out of the use of these images and video by GSBA and also waives any and all compensation in regards to any images or videos.



**6. No Involuntary Execution:**

I acknowledge that I have read this Release from Liability and I fully understand the meaning and importance of its contents. I release, in advance, on behalf of myself, my heirs, assigns and estate, any claim for liability against GSBA Germany e.V. and Betriebssportgemeinschaft der BLE e.V., as well as any participant, official, referee, coach, and staff from any claim for liability of any nature arising out of my participation in the tournament. ## Announcement of Demo use of a Shield in Padded „Mixed Weapon“ Competition:

Dear participants,

in Germany any use of nunchucks is forbidden by law, so that we can still offer a varied tournament, the Mixed Weapon Division will only be held as a demo.

Because we want to introduce a shield at the World Championship to get feedback from the participants.

The rules are the same except that the nunchaku is replaced with a shield. The shield can be combined with a Padded Stick (28 inch/ 71.1 cm) or a Long Padded Stick (31 inch/ 78.74 cm).

The rules for using the shield are simple. It may only be used for defense. For security reasons, attacks of any kind with the shield are forbidden.

Product information "Round shield made of foam" for the Demo Mixed Weapon division:

Training shield made of foam with a synthetic leather cover.

The shield was specially developed for HEMA training and practice fights.

The shields are provided by the organizer and have the following dimensions:



## Connectivity to Bonn

- Cologne Bonn Airport (CNG) is the international airport of Germany's fourth-largest city Cologne, and also serves Bonn, former capital of West Germany.
- Cologne Bonn airport is only 49 km (30 mi) south of larger Düsseldorf Airport, the main airport of Rhine-Ruhr, and also competes with Frankfurt Airport, Germany's major international airport, which can be reached from Cologne within 47 minutes by the ICE high-speed train.

### Train

Platforms at Cologne/Bonn Airport station

Cologne/Bonn Airport station is a 4-track railway station on a loop off the Cologne–Frankfurt high-speed line that connects Cologne Bonn Airport to long-distance trains at least once an hour per direction, most of them ICE services.

The station lies directly across both terminals under a large glass roof and features direct connections to the basement of Terminal 2 as well as the check-in area at Terminal 1-C. The S-Bahn line S 13 as well as regional train line RE 6 connects the airport station with Minden (Westf), via Cologne Main Station, Neuss Main Station and Düsseldorf Main Station with an hourly frequency.

RB 27 also stops here and continue to Cologne and Mönchengladbach or Bonn-Beuel and Koblenz.

### Car/ taxi

The airport has its own exit (named Flughafen) on motorway A59 which links it to the city centres of Bonn as well as the Ruhrgebiet.

### Bus

Local bus lines also connect the airport with Cologne (route 161) and Bonn (route SB60). On 28 October 2015, a new coach terminal opened and is used for remote bus services to other German cities and many other European countries.

# Facts of Bonn

The Federal city of Bonn is a city on the banks of the Rhine in the German state of North Rhine-Westphalia, with a population of over 300,000. About 24 km (15 mi) south-southeast of Cologne, Bonn is in the southernmost part of the Rhine-Ruhr region, Germany's largest metropolitan area, with over 11 million inhabitants. It is famously known as the birthplace of Ludwig Van Beethoven in 1770. He spent his childhood and teenage years in Bonn.

Founded in the 1st century BC as a Roman settlement, Bonn is one of Germany's oldest cities. From 1597 to 1794, Bonn was the capital of the Electorate of Cologne, and residence of the Archbishops and Prince-electors of Cologne. From 1949 to 1990, Bonn was the capital of West Germany, and Germany's present constitution, the Basic Law, was declared in the city in 1949. The era when Bonn served as the capital of West Germany is referred to by historians as the Bonn Republic. From 1990 to 1999, Bonn served as the seat of government – but no longer capital – of reunited Germany.

Because of a political compromise following the reunification, the German federal government maintains a substantial presence in Bonn. Roughly a third of all ministerial jobs are located in Bonn as of 2019, and the city is considered a second, unofficial, capital of the country. Bonn is the secondary seat of the President, the Chancellor, the Bundesrat and the primary seat of six federal government ministries and twenty federal authorities. The title of Federal City (German: Bundesstadt) reflects its important political status within Germany.
